SUGGESTED CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS FOR A 4-H CLUB CONSTITUTION

The following is the form of constitution recommended for a 4-H club:

ARTICLE I NAME The name of this club shall be ___ ARTICLE II The object is to provide a means for the four OBJECT square development as suggested by the 4-H's of the club emblem. Any person living in _____ ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP _ who has reached 5 years of age or who has not reached their 19th birthday before January 1st of the current project year. ARTICLE IV **OFFICERS** The officers of this club shall be President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, News Reporter, Song/Recreation Leader and Flag Bearer. ARTICLE V DUTIES OF OFFICERS The president shall preside at all regular meetings of the club and shall call and preside at such special meetings as it may be necessary to call. The Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President in case of his absence or disability. The Secretary shall keep permanent records in the Secretary's Record book, (1) An accurate record of all the meetings including the names of the members present and absent, (2) the program and any business that may be transacted, (3) send to

Secretary's Record book, (1) An accurate record of all the meetings including the names of the members present and absent, (2) the program and any business that may be transacted, (3) send to the Cooperative Extension Agent the officers and a monthly report of the club meetings and activities, (4) issue the call for special meetings by order of the President or Club Leader, (5) collect and forward to the Extension agent at the end of the year the individual record sheet that is required and shall keep such other records as may be required.

The Treasurer shall, (1) receive and keep and account of all funds received and expended by the club, (2) be in position to make a report of the condition of the treasury when requested, (3) file a complete financial report at the close of the club year and, (4) turn over all records and unexpended funds to his successor when elected.

It shall be the duty of the News Reporter to see that a report of all regular and special meetings of the club and other items of interest are given to the local press and to the 4-H office.

It shall be the duty of the Song/Recreation Leader to provide appropriate songs for club meetings and to lead the singing/provide and lead recreation and games for the club.

ARTICLE VI CLUB LEADER

The club shall be under the supervision and guidance of an adult club leader selected by the club and the cooperative Extension Agent of the 4-H Program.

ARTICLES IX RULES OF ORDER Robert's Rules of Order shall be used to govern the procedure at all meetings of the club.
