Terms of the Scholarship

1. If you win this kid, you will be required to attend and exhibit the scholarship animal at Goat camp and the Franklin County fair for the next **two years**.
 - a. The applicant is responsible to find out in advance the requirements to participate at the required events, including health requirements.
 - b. The applicant is responsible to enter the scholarship animal in a timely manner for the required events, along with providing any associated entry fees.
2. The Franklin County 4-H with a committee of volunteers will provide routine check-ups on how the kid is being cared for and raised. If at any time a problem arises with the raising and care of the animal the 4-H educators will be called upon to make an appropriate decision.
3. If at any time the terms of the scholarship are violated the 4-H educators have the right to remove the animal from the care of the youth.
